I was honored to be elected to the U.S. House of Representatives in 2022 after representing San Mateo County in the State Assembly for 10 years and serving as Speaker pro Tempore, serving as a Mayor/Councilmember, and as a small business owner in South San Francisco.

During my first year in Congress, I supported legislation preserving our democracy, tackling climate change, addressing gun violence, protecting reproductive freedoms, and advocated for over \$27 million in federal funding for community projects to improve flood controls, bikeways, roads, and trails.

My District Office staff has worked to return nearly \$2 Million in Social Security and other tax dollars to constituents, resolved nearly 650 passport cases, and responded to over 43,000 letters, emails, and calls from District 15 constituents.

I serve on the Natural Resources Committee and the Science, Space, and Technology Committee. I introduced my first bill, the Weatherization Resilience and Adaptation Program (WRAP) Act, providing assistance to low-income homeowners and affordable housing providers so their properties are more resilient to climate change, and authored legislation to modernize the federal poverty limit to include housing, child care, and health care costs.

I'm proud to be a leader on the Task Force on Strengthening Democracy and have pushed for the passage of H.R.11: the Freedom to Vote Act. This bill would bolster our democracy by protecting voting rights, ending partisan gerrymandering, improving campaign finance, and safeguarding the electoral process.

I respectfully ask for your vote, so I can continue to fight for the future of our democracy and our planet so this and future generations may thrive.
